

DANenet Public Access Lab Projects

DANenet is pleased to announce the receipt of a grant from the PSC to provide services for public computer labs. We have negotiated with the PSC to provide a package of subsidized services for those labs that want to upgrade or implement new functionality into their computer labs.

Each selected agency will be provided:

- A. Free planning/technology assessment.
- B. Subsidy for major IT projects. (Up to 40 hours / project. Agency cost \$26/hr).
- C. Subsidy for ongoing lab maintenance (Up to 4 hours/month. Agency cost \$16/hr)
- D. Free Staff training on computer lab use (Up to 12 hrs / agency).
- E. \$500 for equipment maintenance.

Requirements for agencies:

- A. Fill out the attached form to tell us what you plan on doing. Projects will be approved on a rolling basis.
- B. Provide a schedule/record of computer lab use including: hours open, classes taught, average number of users in the labs.
- C. Notify DANenet when computer labs are not functioning or Internet access is not available.

Selection criterion for applicants:

- A. Projects must include a public access computer lab (including youth labs).
- B. The labs must include Internet access, although not all of the activities in each lab need include Internet activities (e.g. A multimedia lab might be used both for music production and access to Internet archives of Creative Commons sound files)
- C. Projects will receive priority if they:
 - 1. create/fix/upgrade labs that are heavily used.
 - 2. are feasible and financially viable.
 - 3. introduce new technology into Dane County access labs.
