



Animal Bytes

- Step 1** Students will launch the Internet and go to Sea World.
<http://www.seaworld.org>
- Step 2** Students click on the **Animal Resources** link. This link contains an Animal Information Database from which the students will obtain their facts.
- Step 3** Next, students click on **Animal Bytes**. A long list of animals will appear. They are divided into 7 categories: Mammals, Reptiles, Amphibians, Fish, Insects, Birds and Invertebrates.
- Step 4** Students will scroll through the list and choose five different animals. Once students have clicked on an animal, they should scroll down to **Fun Facts** and rewrite one in their own words. Stress the importance of not copying directly from any source but to put facts into their own words. Make sure to cite the source from which the information came.
- Step 5** Students may check out the rest of the Sea World Web site, there is a great deal of wonderful information here.
- Step 6** Extensions may include: copying and pasting one of the animal graphics or take the information gathered and make it into a mini-book.
